The external factors that can directly affect culture include the rapid development of technology and our inability to properly and correctly apply and use it, the existence of Western popular culture such as music and films, which always depict sadistic and vulgar plots, while internal factors such as the lack or lack of our knowledge of the dangers of instant culture, the lack of family economy (poor families), so most people only accept the influx of instant culture advances that can harm us, the lack of ethical values instilled from the family, leaving us unprepared when Western culture takes hold. In this way we can filter out the worst effects of new and direct culture invading our society and filter them well with a high level of self-confidence.

Pros and Cons Opinions of Various Church Denominations Against Instant Culture

Some of the opinions and responses of various church denominations on Instant Culture are as follows: The Church accepts Instant Culture by being kind and using Instant Culture to strongly support the interests of church ministry. This is taken into account because church and contemporary culture do not overlap but support each other. The Church does not accept Instant Culture because it is unfriendly or even anti-Instant Culture because it views Instant Culture artworks as rivals and threats to the Church, especially Christians, and tends to have a negative impact on the growth of the Church Christians has their churches. The Church accepts and has a positive and critical attitude towards the development of instant culture, which means that on the one hand it accepts works of instant culture art in terms of supporting worship, and on the other hand it is critical of these instant culture values of testing and continuous updating of Works of art and values of

immediate cultural values, so as not to deviate from the teachings of the Word of God and our Pancasila values.

Conclusion

Measuring the Problems of the World of Education, Education field in the current era of globalization is facing big challenges, especially when it is related to its contribution to the formation of modern civilization and culture that is relevant to the development of science and technology (IPTEK).
